WHAT I DID

I relocated 16 Elephants. 6 went to a reserve where there hadn't been Elephants in over 100 years. 10 went to Buffalo Kloof which is where I was posted and met Warne & Wendy Rippon. I filmed the release of the 10 at Buffalo Kloof and got to see them happy and eating away in their new home the very next day. This is where I got 'that feeling!'. That this is what I should be doing with my life right now.

After traveling with these insanely beautiful creatures over 1,200 kms to their new location, I witnessed the Elephant's gingerly exiting the trailer, steady their legs again and take their first steps to their new life in far safer environment, out of harms reach from poachers!

I have honestly never felt such joy in my heart for another living group of creatures in my entire life. It is with no doubt, you would feel it too (when) you experience it, as we have opportunities for our sponsors to come visit us and take part in one of these life changing events! Hopefully there will be many!



WHY I WILL CONTINUE

During my African Adventure, I met many Incredible people, dedicated to Elephant & Rhino and Wildlife conservation. People that have dedicated their entire lives to trying to prevent these Animals from being poached, hunted and driven into extinction.


We are now, amazingly so, super proud to announce our official partnership with **Conservation Solutions** who have agreed to move animals, specifically Elephants & Rhinos for us.




